

## Parking Information

- Any UNI student who plans to bring a car to campus must purchase a UNI parking permit. Visit <http://www.uni.edu/publicsafety/parking-division-vehicle-permits> for information on which vehicle permit you are able to purchase, and <http://www.uni.edu/publicsafety/parking-division-permit-costs> for permit costs.

- If you would like to order a parking permit, log into MyUNiverse and click on *Life@UNI*. Under the section *Parking on Campus*, click on *Parking Permit*. You will be taken to the login screen and after logging in, you will be taken to the parking permit application. Permit charges will be placed on your U-Bill. If you order a parking permit online, we will hand it out to you during Jump Start week.
- If you would like a parking permit but haven't ordered one online in advance, you will be able to fill out a parking permit registration card during Jump Start check-in on Sunday, August 14.

## On-Campus Housing Information

- **Before checking into your residence hall**, check into the Jump Start Program in the Curris Business Building.
- Remember to bring your **student ID card**. You will need this card for entrance into the building when doors are locked in the evening. If you have not yet received your student ID card, ask for a temporary housing access card at residence hall check-in on Sunday. Jump Start staff will then help you obtain your student ID on Monday.
- Bring the **Emergency Contact Information Form** with you on move-in day, available at <http://www.uni.edu/dor/sites/default/files/Housing/PersonalDataEmergencyInformation.pdf>. If you have not completed this form prior to move-in day, you will be able to complete one during your residence hall check-in process.
- When checking into your residence hall, follow the sign to the hall office/check-in area. Please note that parking in CP lots right next to residence halls is limited to one hour during move-in week. You will need to park next to your assigned building, unload your vehicle, and then move your car back to a C or R parking lot (if your car will stay overnight) or to the A lot on the West side of Gilchrist Hall (if parking just for the day).
